Duration of the studies: 7 semesters (3.5 year)

Language of instruction: English


Tuition fee: 4000 PLN per semester

Study programme

General requirements for candidates

- Required documents for admission to bachelor programme:
- personal questionnaire - application form for studies with the candidate's signature (printout from the ISR - Online Registration Platform),
- a photocopy of the secondary school certificate (with the list of grades) legalised or with an apostille, with the positive evaluation of biology, chemistry or mathematics on your secondary school certificate;
- translation into Polish or English of the diploma referred to in point 2, if it is drawn up in a foreign language or English version of the document,
- a medical certificate stating that there are no contraindications for the candidate to study on the chosen programme – issued by the International Mobility Office upon request,
- photocopy of the ID card or other document confirming the identity of the candidate for studies,
- current color photograph which should be uploaded in ISR,
- declaration of readiness to take up studies (printout from ISR),
- official confirmation that presented diploma entitles its holder to take up further education (at bachelor level) in the country of issue (eligibility statement).
- All documents must be sent electronically to the email address admission@zut.edu.pl according to the schedule.
- Hard copies of the documents must be presented after arrival and registration at University.



English language requirements

(2 options)

- photocopy of a document confirming knowledge of the English language (in which the studies will be conducted): Certificate of English language B2 (so called the First Certificate in English) (issued not later than 2 years before)
- or the certificate with positive evaluation of attended English course and, accordingly, the interview with the commission of academic teachers from Faculty of Food Science and Fisheries, and English lector of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin, Poland

Job perspectives

Anticipated places of employment for graduates:

- in facilities dealing with aquaculture of fish, invertebrates and algae,
- in supervision of the work at hatcheries in stocking centres,
- in public administration units,
- in organisations dealing with certification of aquaculture and fisheries,
- in water quality and environmental protection laboratories,
- in units implementing modern water reclamation technologies,
- in units dealing with water management organisation,
- on Polish and foreign fleet vessels,
- in companies designing modern fishing tools safe for the aquatic environment,
- in water tourism companies,
- in their own fish breeding business.

Recruitment "step by step"

Step 1. Registration in the online system for a chosen programme.

Step 2. Verification of documents confirming previous education (secondary school certificate or bachelor degree diploma).

Step 3. Information on qualification (after verification of secondary school certificate or bachelor degree diploma).

Step 4. Submission of required documents – if the number of prequalified candidates is sufficient.

Step 5. Confirmation of qualification and admission.
